

# Sharing classrooms, sharing worlds

World CLIL 2022

7-8 July 2022, The Hague, The Netherlands

In classrooms on all populated continents of the world, learners are engaged in learning content in a language that they do not speak at home. Depending on where you are, you may know this as Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL) or under another name. Through such approaches, learners develop as language users but also have the opportunity to broaden their horizons and to grow as global citizens. In these uncertain and even tumultuous times, having the knowledge, skills and attitudes to communicate across and within cultures and communities has never been more important.

## Who?

Against this backdrop and in the spirit of strengthening our own international community, the <u>World CLIL 2022</u> conference aims to bring together **teachers**, **policy-makers and researchers** from diverse cultural, linguistic and professional backgrounds.

### What?

The programme will include practical workshops, research presentations, good practices, discussion panels and networking opportunities. We welcome practical and research contributions reflecting educational contexts in which the language(s) of instruction is/are not the learners' main home language, such as CLIL, EMI, immersion, dual language or heritage language programmes. We will also invite proposals for symposia focusing on CLIL in specific linguistic, national or cultural contexts, which can be held in languages other than English. In doing so, we hope to broaden our own horizons and learn from the diversity of our learners, our contexts and our practices.

# When and where?

The two-day conference will be held on **7-8 July 2022**. The main location for the conference will be in **the Hague**, **the Netherlands**. In order to include as many delegates as possible, however, there will also be opportunities to attend **parts of the conference online**.

### What next?
